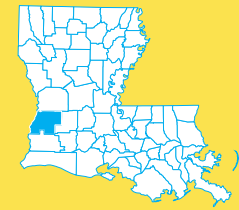


Beauregard



Opportunities for Growth

- Early and adequate prenatal care in Beauregard fell by 30.5 percentage points between 2011 and 2021.
- Beauregard's immunization rate for children ages two-year-olds, at 61% in 2021, was 13 percentage points below the statewide average.
- 8th grade math proficiency in Beauregard declined between 2011 and 2021, while most parishes saw improvements.

Areas of Strength

- Beauregard Parish's 2021 child poverty rate (20%) was seven percentage points lower than the statewide average.
- Beauregard Parish's cohort graduation rate (93%) in 2021 was 9 percentage points higher than the state average.
- The percentage of low birthweight babies in Beauregard Parish fell by 0.9 percentage points between 2010 and 2021, from 9.3% to 8.4%.

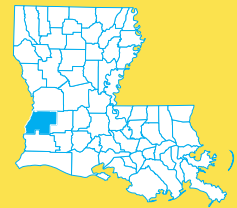
