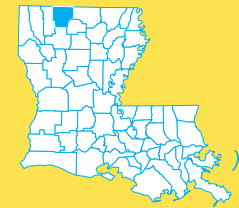


Claiborne



Opportunities for Growth

- 69% of Claiborne Parish residents were considered Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed.
- The teen birth rate in Claiborne Parish, at 39.9 births per 1,000 females ages 15-19, was 63% higher than the statewide average in 2021.
- The average ACT score among seniors in Claiborne Parish, at 15.2, was 2.9 points lower than the statewide average in 2022.

Areas of Strength

- Claiborne Parish's cohort high school graduation rate in 2021 was >95%.
- Between 2011 and 2021, the percentage of births to women who received early and adequate prenatal care rose by 6.4 percentage points.
- In 2020, 96% of children in Claiborne Parish had health insurance.

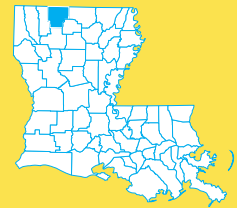
