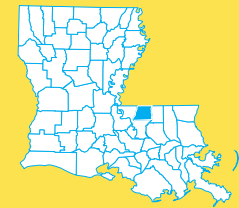


East Feliciana



Opportunities for Growth

- East Feliciana's rate of low birthweight babies increased by 1.4 percentage points between 2010 and 2021.
- The percentage of births to East Feliciana mothers who received early and adequate prenatal care decreased by 5.3 percentage points between 2011 and 2021.
- In 2021, 17% of East Feliciana 8th graders scored at Mastery or above in math, compared to 21% statewide.

Areas of Strength

- East Feliciana Parish's immunization rate for young children was ranked 11th-highest in the state in 2021.
- It is estimated that over 95% of low-income preschoolers (ages 3-4) had a publicly funded seat in an early care and education program in 2021.
- The average ACT score in East Feliciana improved by 0.9 points between 2010 and 2022, even as the statewide average fell by two points.

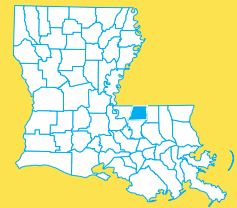
