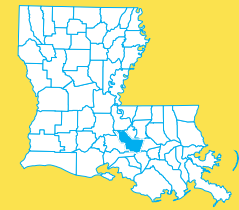


Iberville



Opportunities for Growth

- In 2021, 16% of Iberville Parish 8th graders scored at Mastery or above in math, which was five percentage points below the state average.
- In 2021, 17.2% of Iberville babies were born with low birthweight, which was 5.8 percentage points higher than the state average.
- The average ACT score for Iberville high school seniors (17.1) was a point lower than the state average in 2022.

Areas of Strength

- A higher proportion of children were fully immunized by age two in Iberville Parish than in any other parish in 2021.
- Iberville's graduation rate increased by 42 percentage points between 2010 and 2021, from 47% to 89%.
- In 2021, over 95% of children ages 3-4 from low-income families had a publicly funded early care and education seat.
