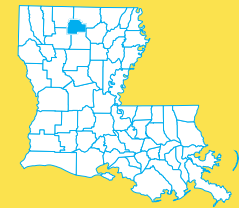


Lincoln



Opportunities for Growth

- In 2021, 73.6% of Lincoln babies were born to mothers who received early and adequate prenatal care.
- In 2021, 64% of Lincoln Parish residents lived in households with earnings below the ALICE (Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed) threshold.
- The rate of low birthweight babies in Lincoln Parish rose by 2.3 percentage points between 2010 and 2021.

Areas of Strength

- The teen birth rate in Lincoln Parish, at 10.1 births per 1,000 females ages 15-19, was the second-lowest of any parish in 2021.
- 81% of low-income Lincoln Parish children ages 3-4 had a publicly funded early care and education seat in 2021.
- Lincoln Parish's infant mortality rate was 39% lower than the statewide average in 2017-2021.

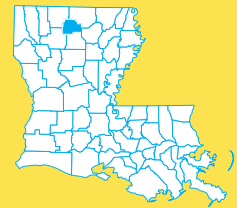
