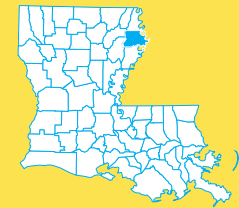


Madison



Opportunities for Growth

- Nearly half of all children in Madison Parish lived in poverty in 2021, ranking the parish 61 out of 64 parishes on this measure.
- In 2021, just 41% of Madison Parish children were fully immunized by age two, which was the lowest rate of any parish.
- Madison had the state's lowest graduation rate in 2021, when 50% of students graduated on time.

Areas of Strength

- An estimated 97% of children in Madison Parish had health insurance in 2020.
- In 2021, 22% of Madison Parish infants and toddlers from low-income families were served in a publicly funded early care and education seat, which was double the state average.
- The infant mortality rate in Madison Parish declined by 16% between 2008-2012 and 2017-2021.
