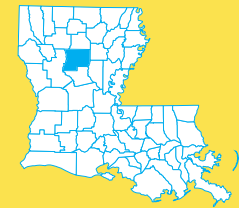


Winn



Opportunities for Growth

- Winn's child poverty rate (34%) was seven percentage points higher than the state average in 2021.
- Births to Winn women who received early and adequate prenatal care fell by 5.5 percentage points between 2011 and 2021, from 73.9% to 68.4%.
- 46% of low-income children ages 3-4 had a publicly funded early learning seat, which was 12 percentage points below the state average in 2021.

Areas of Strength

- Winn Parish's rate of low birthweight babies (9.2%) was the 12th-lowest in the state in 2021.
- Winn's graduation rate improved by 22 percentage points between 2010 and 2021, rising from 65% to 87%.
- In 2020, 96% of Winn Parish children had health insurance.

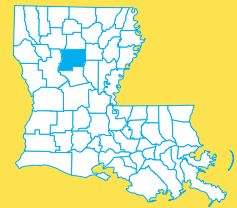
